Documentation tool was helpful

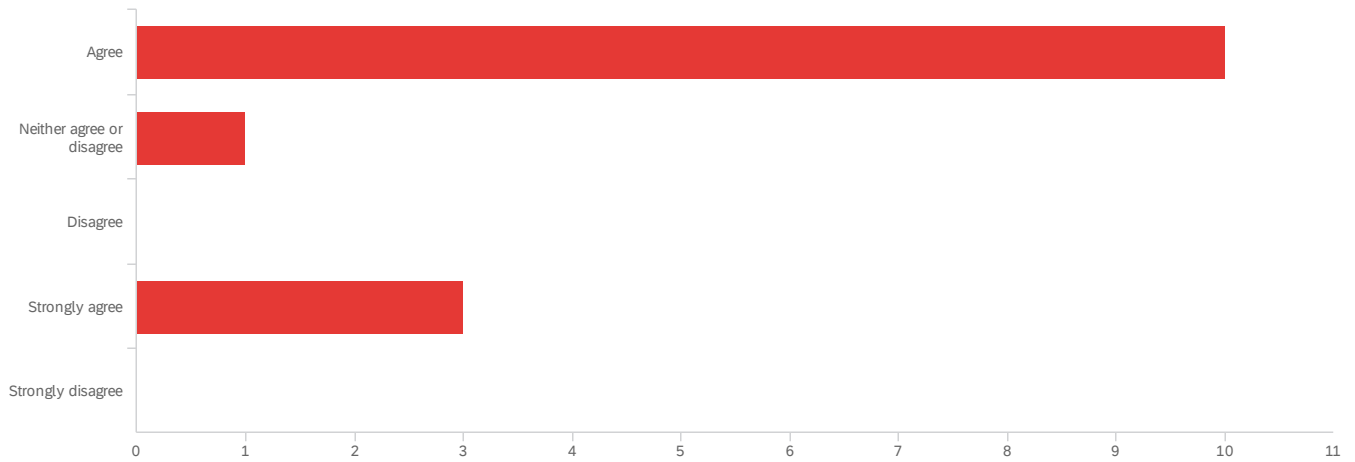
Maybe if the video links were easier to find

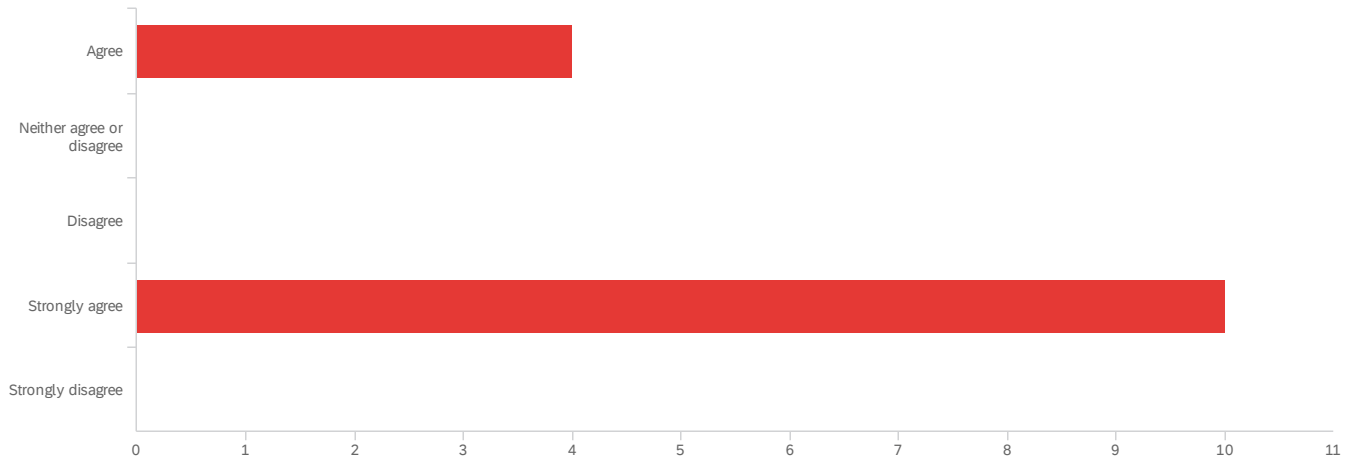

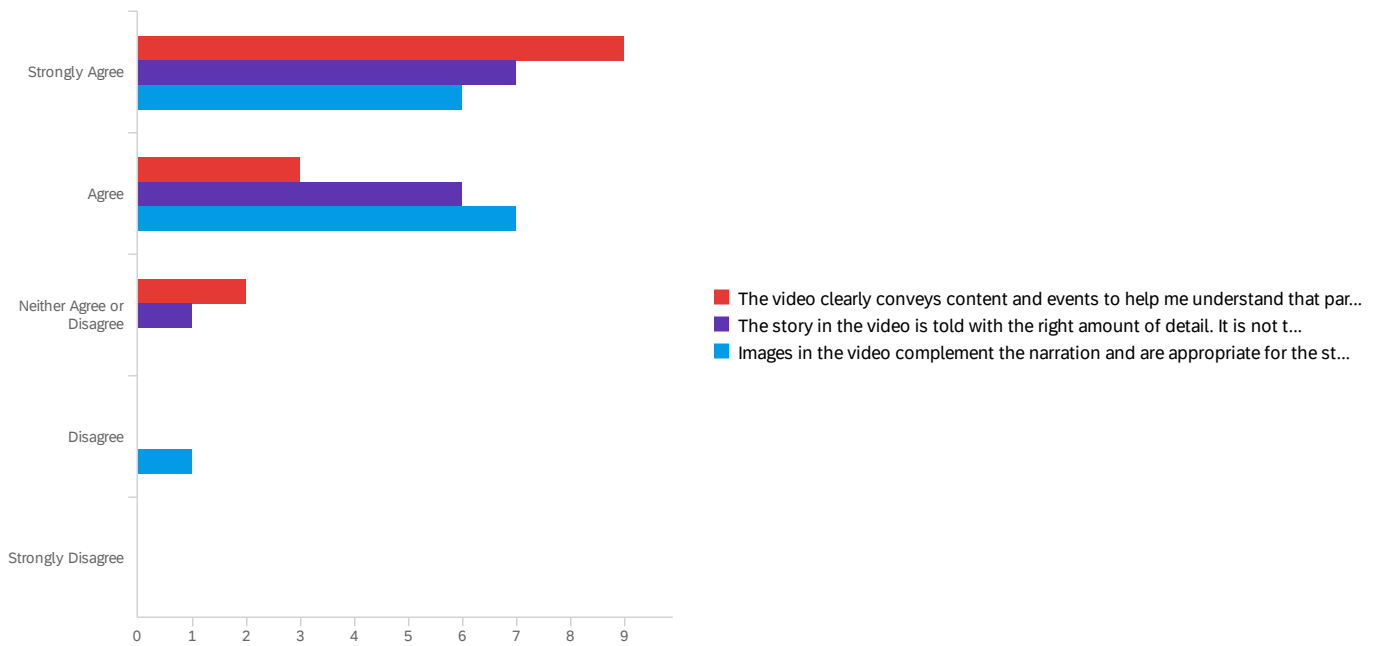

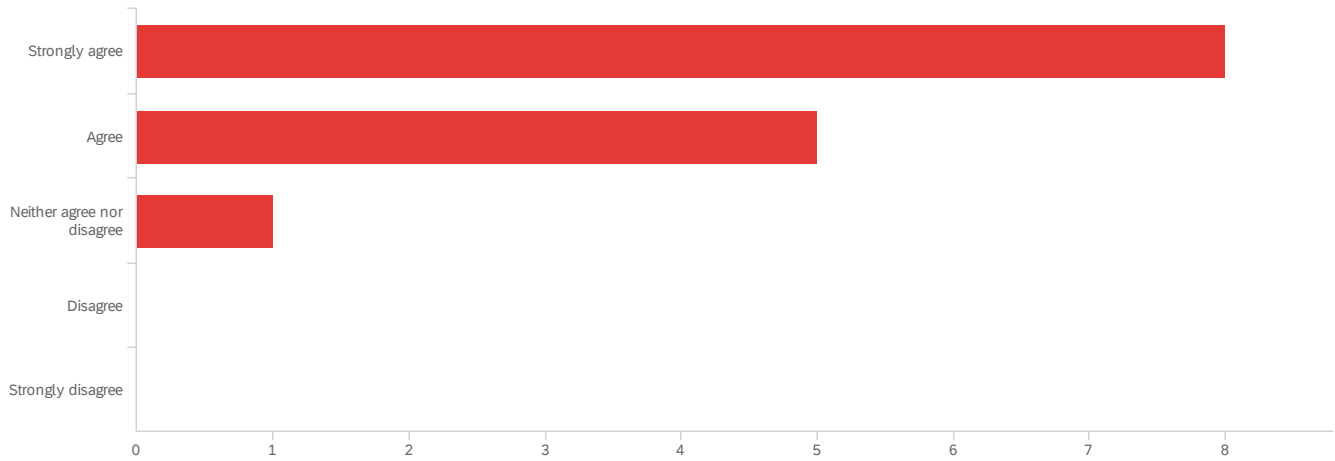

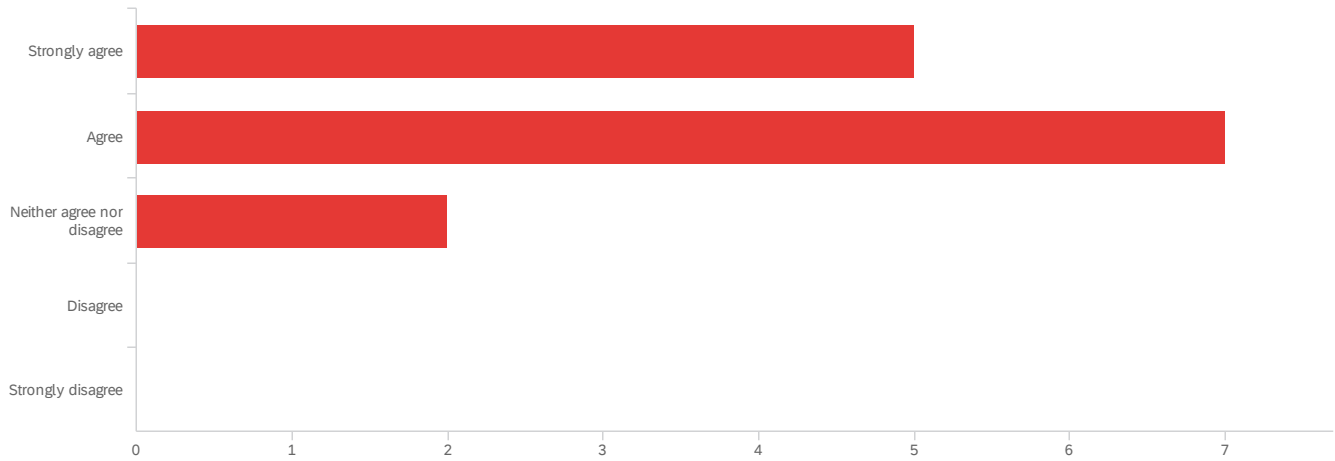

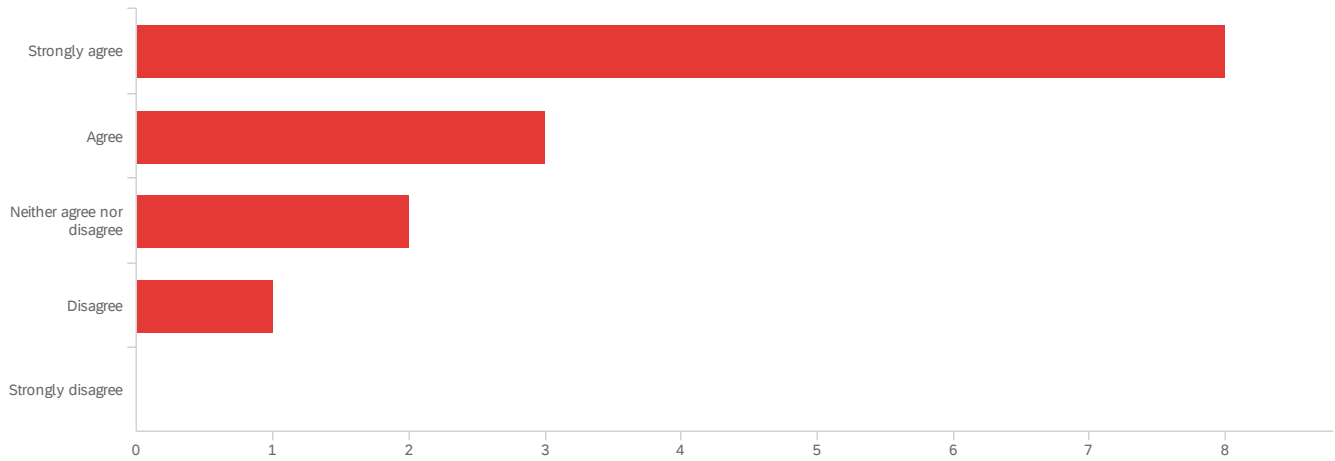
