  - SACE Stage 2 Japanese is assumed knowledge for the major and sub-major in Japanese;
  - SACE Stage 2 English or SACE Stage 2 English Literary Practice is assumed knowledge for the major and sub-major in English.
- Students must complete one Elective as part of their undergraduate program from the Electives list below
