## **Choosing your elective**

The MMET Master of Teaching (Secondary) program requires the completion of one elective course (4.5 units) which enhances your professional expertise in an area.

The elective can be taken in any Study Period during the program, but it is important to keep in mind that in Study Period 4 of the first year there is a five-week practicum, and this can make it difficult to find an elective which does not clash with placement requirements. It is our recommendation that you take your elective in SP2 of either your first or second year. Please note that if you choose to take your elective in your second year, you will need to take RP2 in SP4.
