



Punctuation: question marks (?)

Question marks are separation marks which are used to show when a direct question has been asked.

1. Question marks are placed at the end of a sentence which asks a question

Examples

- Is your exam tomorrow or the day after?
- What are your plans for the future?

2. When you directly report another person's question you *do not* use a question mark

Example

- My supervisor asked me when I expected to finish my thesis.
