### Mystery Message

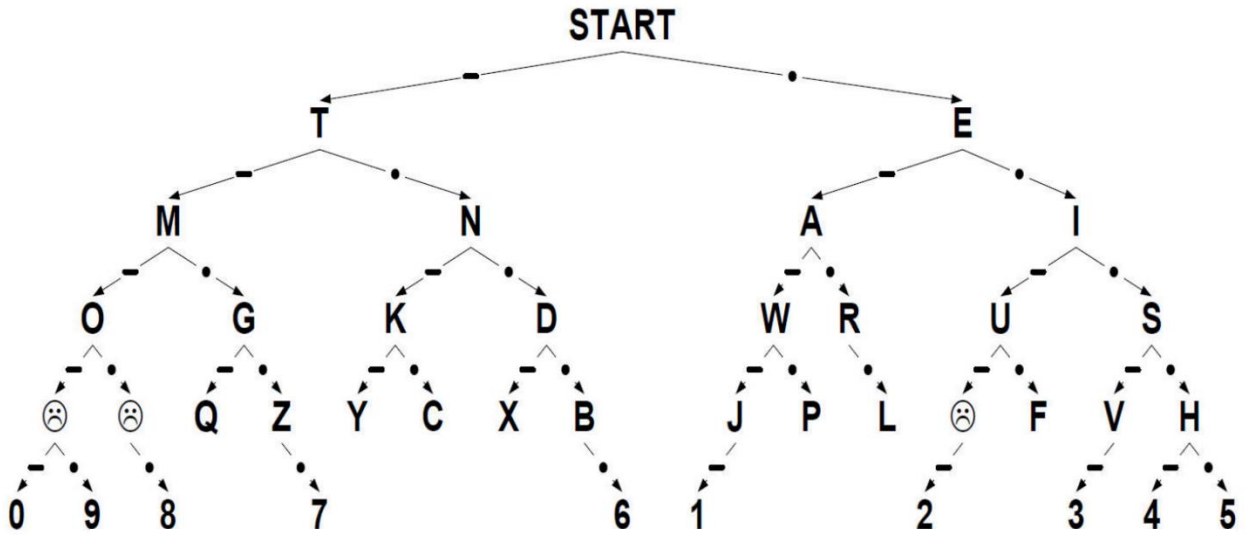
The astronauts on the International Space Station have lost their standard communication channels. They have sent a Morse Code message and you need to translate it to help rescue them.
