

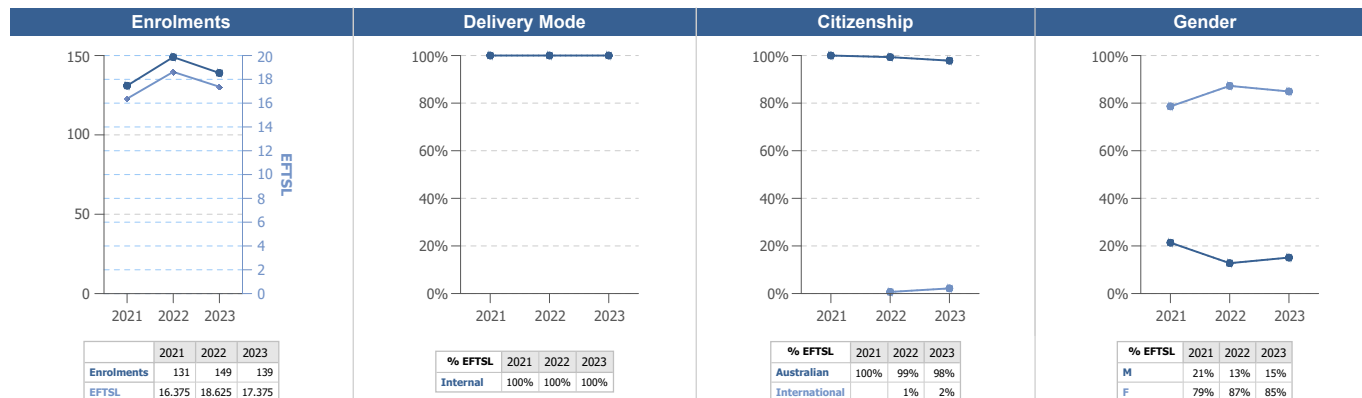

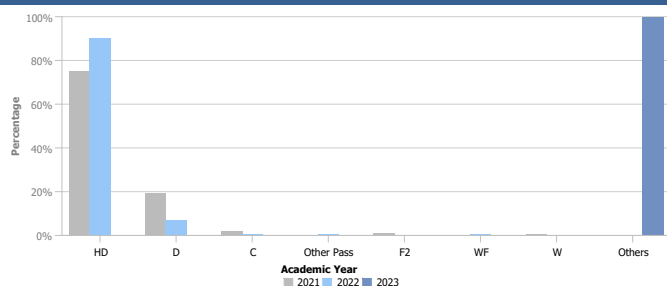

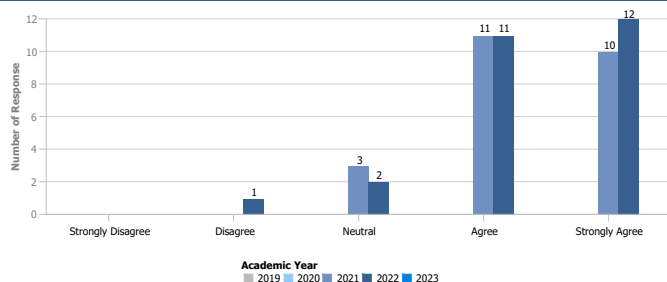


Grade Distribution

Course Overall Satisfaction

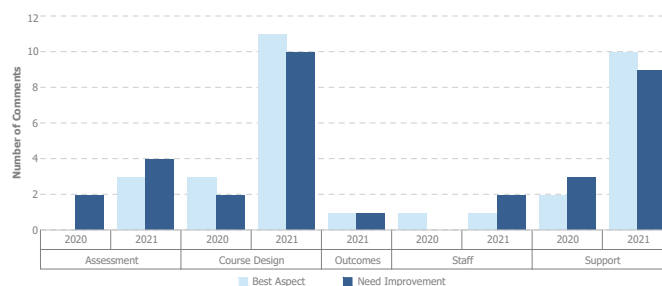

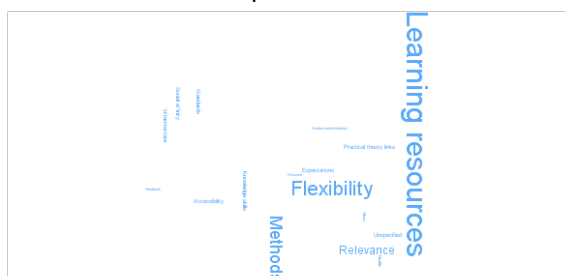

I would like to see fingers included in the course and perhaps more direction on which bits to concentrate on for pre exam study as the anatomy alone was a huge workload. the readings included all the nerve pathways etc which I found extremely overwhelming

SP5 - 2021	IGSO	I think that each module should have a summary virtual class. It is incredibly difficult to have confidence I am on track and having the learning/thought process that is being taught. I understate at level 2 courses we need to be more independent but giving the class a study guide and go read a text book instruction is not filling gaps that do turn up. Ask questions/message the lecturer? there are some things that for me personally is difficult in explaining and having a running conversation vs having that aspect with a a video/zoom. This has been a recurring style of each course for the sonography program. I am also in a personal disadvantage with my clinical position being in a remote and rural Australia with no permanent senior sonographer to seek advice whenever I can. When I do get bulk blocks of scanning time then its great. I understand that is a separate issue but the point im making is that there are students who need no further additional modes of resources as they have the best thing they could possibly have - a supportive experienced department of sonographers and radiologists to students like myself who need more than hundreds of pages of notes and the internet. I have also found it incredibly difficult to keep on top of my studies with the content being extensive (unfortunately we are tasked with learning forever)

I dont understand why that is barrier to releasing videos and student watch at their own pace? This is a level 2 course and we shouldnt be spoon feed the information? we should still be given ample and frequent multimedia.

However, Bianci might be a bit too detailed and outside the scope of learning for this particular course. Another main reading that meets halfway between the two would be perfect - Inclusion of finger and toe scans - since medicare changed their billing, referrals for these areas have become more common. - More images in the study guides (although I just added in my own)

I know we had the ESSR papers on MSK that showed similar things but I find a video demonstration would be better. Some of the lecture materials were ok but lack details. more interactive Zoom session would be great as well.

Running through the CDM module itself was also confusing, I found it difficult to progress through the menus without going in circles. More information on the format of the exam, essential content and more practice exams would be helpful. Compared to the MSK scans expected of me at work, I feel maybe the course is a bit basic. For example I could never just do 3/4s of an ankle and not investigate the medial side, I would be considered incompetent. Perhaps an update to some of the modules? Not sure if this applies to most workplaces though, I work in a private clinic where we do most scans (no VVs, poad spine or brain, but we do everything else).

Some modules had good powerpoint lectures, and some didn't. I'd be nice if future students have a good lecture on how to scan, and anatomy, pathology etc in online lecture form. It'd be nice this way especially for students like me who don't see any sports injury in the clinical placement setting. I also think week by week approach can be better for some students rather than autonomous approach to the modules: me and my clinical tutor both agreed this way can be better for the clinical tutors to follow up students' academic knowledge, thus corresponding clinical education can be arranged. I also struggled with my assignment and I've noticed some of the other students were going through the same thing on the discussion board. It was little bit confusing to know what the course was expecting us to do. I spent so much time on the assignment to cover all the areas that were required by the marking rubric, but it was much over the presentation time limit and I had to exclude so much good materials I've researched. I didn't get good mark from it, and did not receive any feedback. I'd be nice if I had a feedback so I know what was missing from my work. Otherwise, very enjoyable course!

Also, double submission of a powerpoint AND a script is extra work. I understand it is for turnitin but doubling the work is still annoying.
SP5 - 2022	IMSO	Layout of the learn online site - I had difficulty finding resources and found there were multiple folders for one topic eg. there was a preparation for online examination folder but the main practice quiz was under the examination tab. The question and answers resource for each module is fantastic however I would have found it beneficial to be an actual practice quiz rather than a pdf document. It would have been helpful to have a zoom session about the assignment as there were lots of questions from students and I found you had to go searching through the discussion forum to understand what was expected of the assignment.
