

RADY 5031-Advanced Obs and Gyn Sonography

Final presentation/Publication task

This is a compulsory graded component, **worth 17.5 % of the marks** for this course.

The final assignment is a project report which will essentially be constructed in the form of a presentation or publication, which may, with some further development beyond the course, be submitted to a conference or journal.

Note that the final project must contain the following components

1)Abstract: 200 words in the format of background, methods, results and conclusion and take-home message

2) A reflective statement: approximately 100 words, which clearly communicates reflections on what completing this project has meant for students in terms of assisting them to think about your scanning practice. For example, what they got out of the exercise; what they have learned; what they know they still need to learn; if anything surprised, concerned or challenged them; what the project might mean for their scanning practice in the future.

3) A 10-minute professional power-point presentation submitted via the eportfolio if they choose the presentation option, or a written submission on the topic. (They can choose either presentation or a written submission-both together are not required).

The following **marking criteria** apply to this project report:

- The Project demonstrates engagement with a relevant body of knowledge;
- Adequate and relevant theory supports the argument in a scholarly way.
- The Project has a clear structure and substance
- The argument is communicated clearly
- The argument exhibits higher level thinking
- There is ethical handling of any data

If they are considering a case report for publication, usually patient consent forms are required. An example of Wiley patient consent form is provided.

If students are planning to publish a clinical audit, ethics approval needs to be in place for publication, and all patient data needs to be de-identified.
