The purpose of work experience placement is to provide an opportunity for students to undertake unpaid work at Harrold & Kite Pty Ltd to:

- Develop skills in the workplace by undertaking meaningful work

Students would be required to:

- Be available for 12 16 hours each week and would provide their own transport between home, Harrold & Kite Pty Ltd Offices (238 Wright St, Adelaide), building sites and the University of South Australia
- Select the hours worked to suit their study schedule, however a typical working day starts at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 4:30pm
- Undertake a WHS Induction on the first day
- Undertake a Building Industry white card induction training (1-day course). This training is required for anyone wishing to work in the Construction Industry or go onto a building site.
- Provide Steel capped boots for site visits to building sites.

We note that whilst the work experience is unpaid, Harrold & Kite Pty Ltd. would fund the Building Industry white card induction training for each student and will provide all personal protective equipment (PPE) except for steel capped boots (which are required when attending building sites).

This Work experience program aims to begin in July 2017 and will run for 12 months' period. Interested students are asked to email their completed expression of interest to <u>admin@harrkite.com.au</u> by the 9th June 2017 should they wish to be considered for this program.

Harrold & Kite will review all expressions of interest received and will prepare a short list of potential candidates for interview prior to any placements being confirmed.
