# KGU Winter School in Japan (with Kwansei Gakuin University)

This three-week program is designed for students who want to learn about Japan, including contemporary Japanese culture, animation, games and traditional Japanese cuisine. Students will also have the chance to participate in various types of Japanese cultural activities, such as Yuzen dyeing and making Japanese traditional sweets. Participation in this program does not require any Japanese language skills, so this is a great opportunity to explore "Cool Japan" and add a global experience to your studies.
